Audition Process for the 2024-25 Season

Auditions are held by YOUTUBE submission. Apply for an audition at peninsulayouthorchestra.org. As soon as your application is received, you will be emailed specific instructions for your YOUTUBE audition. Your audition video will be be reviewed a few days after submission, and your placement results will be emailed within a day or two. You may also attend a rehearsal with a friend and audition during the rehearsal break. This will expedite the process!

Audition Requirements

PYO Senior Orchestra:

2 major scales, 2 minor scales, Solo Bach OR Etude and 1 solo

Preparatory Full Orchestras & String Orchestras:

2 major scales, 2 minor scales, 1 etude and 1 solo

- Beginner: Debut Strings, Sinfonia Musica (suggest 1-octave scales)
- Intermediate: Concordia Strings, Orchestra Nova (suggest 2- or 3-octave scales)
- Advanced: Peninsula Young Artists (PYA)

Note: 3 octave scales & repertoire with upper position work required for PYA strings

Flute Ensembles:

2 major scales, 2 minor scales, 1 etude and 1 solo

Membership is open to all students, ages 6-18, who wish to study orchestral repertoire in an educational setting. *PYO highly recommends its members participate in their school's instrumental music program. The school programs offer opportunities for daily ensemble participation, which is then complemented by their involvement in PYO. On the audition application, we ask that you speak with your music teachers about enrolling in PYO. We are proudly working together to support instrumental music programs in all schools!*

Full Orchestras - The Peninsula Youth Orchestra, now serving around 400 musicians, offers weekly instruction in orchestral training at the beginning, intermediate and advanced levels. All PYO ensembles study the traditional repertoire with an emphasis on contemporary literature and works by American composers. The full orchestra program includes the award winning Peninsula Youth Orchestra (PYO) under the direction of Mitchell Sardou Klein, and three preparatory orchestras under the direction of Sara Salsbury: Sinfonia Musica, Orchestra Nova, and the Peninsula Young Artists (PYA).

The senior-level Peninsula Youth Orchestra—which bears the same name as the organization—is PYO's most advanced symphonic ensemble, composed of around 100 string, woodwind, brass, and percussion players. Under the direction of Music Director Mitchell Sardou Klein and Assistant Conductor Jason Kneebone, the orchestra members gain the skills and knowledge needed to play challenging repertoire from the orchestral canon, as well as exciting, new works by living composers. The musicians have regular sectionals with Bay Area musicians throughout the season.

The Peninsula Youth Orchestra (PYO) performs 4-5 major concerts each season, tours biannually, and makes special appearances for community events. PYO has toured in Japan, New Zealand, Australia, Italy, France, Spain, Hungary, Austria, the Czech Republic, Germany, Belgium, England, the Netherlands and the Baltics. The ensemble has performed twice in the Bay Area Youth Orchestra Festival at Davies Symphony Hall.



Summer Touring with our PYA and PYO musicians has been an important part of the PYO experience. PYO members who have been with us on our amazing tours to Europe, Asia or Australia have had special experiences that last a lifetime. When we tour internationally, the excitement of performing is heightened, the quality of our playing reaches a new level and we share unique, inspiring and life-changing moments. Plans are underway for a 2024 summer international tour for the senior PYO under the direction of Maestro Klein.





The Preparatory Full Orchestra Artistic Staff, all professional musicians and educators, apply their expertise by working with young musicians in a positive and respectful manner while guiding them through a sequential program of orchestral musicianship (applauded by the California Arts Council). Three preparatory full orchestras receive weekly sectionals with these specialists, in addition to full orchestra rehearsals under the direction of Sara Salsbury. The Preparatory Orchestras present three major concerts each season and often perform for community events. The Peninsula Young Artists have performed in New York City at Carnegie Hall, the Mozart Festival in Austria, China, the Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles, Ireland, London, Paris and participated in the "Beethoven to Dvorak Festival" held in the Dvorak Hall in Prague.
